He participated in the Prin-2008 project "Approximate and simplified likelihoods for estimation and forecasting" (ref. Prof. P. Vidoni). As an expert in multivariate statistical analysis, he is involved in various projects in nursing management analysis (ref. Prof. A. Palese) both at the national (such as, for example, the SVIAT project) and international levels (Strengthening knowledge and competencies of Nurse Managers for a Safe care environment, ITO2 Erasmus+ National Agency - INDIRE). He is involved in the Prin-2015 project on "Likelihood-free methods of inference". Participated in the ASSIC COMET project in "Machine learning and formal methods for smart systems integrations and intelligent sensors" (ref. prof. A. Montanari).
