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Currently, he is the Sector Delegate of the Rector of the University of Udine for Teacher Training, and the Director of the Departmental Centre for Learning, Education and Training (CEDA) at the Department of Languages and Literatures, Communication, Education and Society.

His primary areas of research are educational theory and research in socio-culturally complex formal, non-formal and informal contexts, which also encompass a focus on different ages of life and on innovative, intercultural and inclusive learning environments. He has participated in international and national research projects and communities, and has published books, chapters and articles listed in the research catalogue Cineca IRIS of the University of Udine (<https://air.uniud.it>).

He is active in both pre-service and in-service training of teachers and educators on issues related to education and learning in socially and culturally heterogeneous educational services, schools, neighbourhoods and communities, with a special reference to approaches inspired by action- and participative-research.
